Math	<ul> <li>★ Practice your BASIC FACTS every week.</li> <li>Addition and subtraction facts should be automatic- NOT require finger-counting.</li> <li>&gt; Practice addition and subtraction WITH regrouping so you don't forget it!</li> <li>&gt; KNOW your multiplication facts through the 12's.</li> <li>o Practice your facts with flash cards.</li> <li>o Use your Summer Journal to write lists of the fact families.</li> <li>o Play multiplication "WAR" with playing cards.</li> <li>o Use your IXL account for additional practice.</li> </ul>
Religion	<ul> <li>★ Attend Mass with your family when you can.</li> <li>★ Even when you are on vacation, remember God is with you. Keep strong in your faith by praying and doing your best to help your parents and serve others.</li> <li>★ Use your Summer Journal to write your thoughts, feelings, and questions about your faith.</li> </ul>
